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1. INTRODUCTION

COUSIN SURGERY's Purchasing function is committed to a responsible purchasing approach to contribute to the company's overall performance.

This approach allows to:

- Support the achievement of COUSIN SURGERY's CSR requirements
- Contribute to the objective of reducing CO2 emissions by decarbonizing our purchases and limiting our waste production
- Better manage purchasing risks,
- Promote the local economic fabric
- To be attentive to the ethics of business relationships
- Guarantee the respect of payment deadlines
- COUSIN SURGERY is a signatory of the RFAR charter (Responsible Purchasing and Supplier Relations).

COUSIN SURGERY's Purchasing function is committed to:

- Implement an action plan to comply with the 10 commitments of the RFAR charter
- Contribute to the application of the company's environmental policy by reducing the environmental impact of our purchases.

2. THE STRATEGY

In order to meet the commitments of this responsible purchasing policy, the Purchasing function is committed to a structured approach with several areas of work and progress.

The success of this policy is based on sharing this progress approach and working closely with all internal contacts (specifiers, users, accountants, lawyers, etc.) as well as external contacts (suppliers, subcontractors, service providers, etc.).

The success of this policy depends on integrating sustainable development into the company's purchasing practices and systematically taking this dimension of performance into account.

This is reflected in the purchasing process by a reflection on needs in cooperation with specifiers and internal users, the consideration of sustainable development in the choice of the supply solution, and the integration of CSR criteria during supplier evaluations.

To monitor the performance of its responsible purchasing policy, COUSIN SURGERY has set up a system of CSR indicators. These indicators allow us to measure the level of performance achieved for each objective, and to be part of a progress approach.

Acting on the company's environmental issues

- To take into account the CSR (social and environmental) approaches of our suppliers, during consultations by integrating specifications and evaluation criteria.

5. ETHICS AT COUSIN SURGERY

COUSIN SURGERY's reputation has been built on the quality of its services and the trust that customers place in it. The respect of the best practices in terms of ethics is thus required from all COUSIN SURGERY employees but also from each supplier.

Because ethics is one of our core values, COUSIN SURGERY does not accept any transgression in this area from either its employees or its suppliers.

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6. ANTI-BRIBERY POLICY
